The collection—which is handcast using the "lost wax" method to capture the design's exquisite details—is available in rectangular or arched profiles. And, the design is offered in knob, lever and thumblatch grip options.





Hammered

The Hammered collection harkens to the deft work of old world blacksmiths, and best reflects the premium the brand places on personal craftsmanship and attention to detail. The richly textured assortment—which was created from hand-carved molds to enliven the tactile surface of each piece—is offered in an array of knob and lever and escutcheon designs.
